

Arts/Craft Class Leader Volunteer

Crafty folks needed! Do you have a craft skill you are willing to share with others? Plant It Again is looking for class leaders to teach their craft to community members with developmental and intellectual disabilities that are starting microbusinesses. We are a vocational training program that focuses on sustainability and building community. To learn more about our organization, visit PlantItAgain.org.

Class Leaders are asked to be available just one day a month on a weekday from 10am-2pm to teach their craft to a small group of learners, usually less than eight per class. There will also be other staff in the classroom to support you, as we try to have a 1:2 leader to learner ratio. If you have the time and talent to teach more than one craft, we'd love to have you on a weekly or bi-weekly basis.

To get started, send us a message and tell us about yourself and the craft you would want to share. If you have never taught before, don't worry, we can help you. We value your skill, passion, and willingness to invest your time in others. We will contact you to talk about more details and determine if it seems like a good fit, both for you and for us.

- Assist with set-up and clean-up of class
- Encourage development of learners
